



# Association of Part-time Undergraduate Students APUS Award for the U of T Sesquicentennial 2017-2018

For Students on all three campuses of the University of Toronto

**Deadline for submission of forms to APUS is Friday, February 2, 2018 – 4pm**

Each year, the Association of Part-time Undergraduate Students grants up to two awards in the amount of \$400 each to commemorate the University of Toronto's Sesquicentennial Anniversary. The purpose of the Sesquicentennial awards is to recognize part-time undergraduate students who have achieved academic excellence and have also demonstrated outstanding achievement beyond their university studies, or who have overcome particularly adverse circumstances in order to attend university.

## CRITERIA:

1. All applicants must have completed at least **five** full course equivalents [FCE's (i.e. full credits)] at the U of T with a "B" average (a GPA of 3.0) in the best five **AND**,
2. All applicants must have demonstrated outstanding achievement or commitment in activities distinct from their university studies **OR**,
3. **Have overcome particularly adverse circumstances in order to attend university.**
4. All applicants must have been enrolled at the U of T in at least one credit course but no more than three and a half courses during the session for which they are being nominated (*part-time status for the purpose of the APUS bursary and awards for St. George/UTM students is defined as registered in 2.5 or less full course equivalents (F.C.E.s) i.e. credits, over the entire 2017-2018 Fall/Winter Session, for UTSC students it is defined as 1.0 credits or less in a four-month term*) **AND**,
5. All applicants must be nominated by someone with direct knowledge about what the nominee has achieved or overcome; nominees exclude family members or close friends, and should be related to the nominee's activities in a professional way.

## PLEASE NOTE:

- In meeting criterion (2) above, some examples of what kind of activities or circumstances would qualify are: significant voluntary community involvement, or university committee involvement, or student association involvement, or serious health problems. The preceding are broad examples of what might qualify, however, the level of involvement in such activities and/or specific accomplishments will determine the most suitable nominees.
- The following are examples of circumstances that would not meet criterion 2: returning to school after many years away, or working full-time while going to school part-time, or achievement as part of employment, or homemaking and/or raising children. However, any of these may be added *context*, highlighting the achievement/commitment and how it was carried out. In addition, it might also help the committee determine adverse circumstances and how they were overcome.
- There is no limit to the number of times a student may be nominated; however, a student may only win the award **once**.
