

Association of Part-time Undergraduate Students APUS Scholastic Awards 2017-2018

For Students on all three campuses of the University of Toronto

Deadline for submission of forms to APUS is **Friday**, **February 2**, **2018 – 4pm**

Up to twenty (20) APUS Scholastic Awards are granted annually in the sum of \$300 each to reward part-time undergraduate students for their outstanding academic achievement as determined by the Office of Enrolment Services.

CRITERIA:

- All applicants must have successfully completed at least ten full course equivalents [FCEs, (i.e. full credits)] at the University of Toronto AND,
- All applicants must have successfully completed at least four FCEs in one area of specialization (i.e. a major or specialist) AND,
- All applicants must have obtained at least a "B+" average (GPA of 3.3) in the most recent five FCEs completed AND,
- All applicants must have completed the majority of their FCE's on a part-time basis. Part-time status for the purpose of the APUS bursary and awards for St. George/UTM students is defined as registered in 2.5 or less full course equivalents (F.C.E.s) i.e. credits, over the entire 2017-2018 Fall/Winter Session; for UTSC students it is defined as 1.0 credits or less in a four-month term.

PLEASE NOTE:

- The awards will be distributed among applicants in the various disciplines based on their **academic** qualifications.
- Application can be made as often as desired as long as a student meets the criteria, however, a student can win this award only **once**.
- Application can be made in no more than two areas of specialization. An associated course can be used in the area of specialization if the course is so recognized by the department concerned.
- Recipients of this award cannot also receive a Jovita Nagy Scholarship, although they may apply for both awards.
- The Office of Enrolment Services is responsible for determining recipient(s).
